## THE BURMA IMMIGRATION (EMERGENCY PROVISIONS) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1955. [Act No. LVIII of 1955.]

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be called the Burma Immigration (Emergency Provisions) (Amendment) Act, 1955.
- 2. In section 2 of the Burma Immigration (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1947, hereinafter referred to as "the maid Act", in clause (f) of sub-section (1), for the words "who is not below the rank of a Sub-Inspector of Immigration" the words "including an Immigration Constable" shall be substituted.
- 3. For sub-section (2) of section 6 of the said Act, the following shall be substituted, namely:-
  - "(2) It shall be the duty of the carrier who brings in a conveyance to any seaport or airport or land station in the Union of Burma-
    - (a) to stop the conveyance at such place as may be specified by an immigration official not below the rank of a Sub-Inspector of Immigration; and
    - (b) not to remove the conveyance until clearance is granted by an immigration official not below the rank of a Sub-Inspector of Immigration."
